I would be remiss if I did not spend the time (prior to my winter departure for golf in Florida) to give you some feedback on your product, which I purchased in early Spring 2005.

In case you do not remember, I am a former golf professional. I retired from the profession in 1992 at age 37, so I could pursue other interests. I am now 48 years of age. I have an obvious understanding of the game and its fundamentals. I was a +1 to a -5 handicap player over the period of my 12 year golf career. I had great eyesight until age 40, when I found I required eyeglasses.

What follows may sound trite, but I truly cannot emphasize enough my gratitude. I have never felt so completely satisfied with a product, as I have been with your "golfer's glasses".

Between business (unrelated to golf) and age diminishing eyesight, my golf game went from a 5 handicap to a 15 handicap by 2004.

I saw your advertisement early in 2005. I believe I was one of the first to respond. I knew I needed help with my golf game in areas unrelated to the basic fundamentals of the golf swing. I could not bear another year of mis-hit shots and bad reads. I knew the problem did not lay in my knowledge or desire. I was, however, not aware that my "old glasses" were part of the problem. After only 28 rounds and 2 practice sessions in 2005, I am pleased to report that my handicap has gone from a 15 to an 8 at Pointe West Golf Club. I no longer look down at a white sphere hoping for some contact. Once again I can groove my swing to match the dimples and execute the shot I want. The results have me ecstatic. I can hardly wait to recoup my costs in Florida over the winter, playing with the over 40 crowd who have not yet purchased your product. Remember - pros don't die, we just lose our balls. Rest assured I will eventually reveal my secret - your eyeglasses.
